Sexton Mountain Presents 2010 Summer Reading Program

All students are invited to participate in Sexton Mountain's first summer reading program. Students are encouraged to read their way through the summer with books of their choice, exploring personal interests and building skills along the way. The children have worked hard over the course of the school year to improve their reading ability, but they risk losing valuable reading skills over the summer if they don't read. Our program is aimed at maintaining skills and encouraging children to enjoy their reading experiences.

Here's how it works: Simply complete a summer reading program, bring in proof of completion during the first week of school in September, and win an **ice cream party with Principal Martin**. Easy!

Some summer reading programs include:

1) The Beaverton City Library. The Murray Schools branch has scheduled their grand opening for June 25th at noon, but the main branch on 5th Street is currently taking sign ups for their summer "Make a Splash, Read!" program now through July 31st. After reading for 15 hours over the summer, kids will earn a certificate of completion, prizes, and a free book. Bring your **certificate** to your teacher to claim your Party with the Principal.
